This annual event has become a celebration of everything that is great in the British Gun Trade.

The price for the day is £40.00 which includes, clays, buffet style lunch but excludes cartridges.

*High Gun Prize
The Best Of British*

As this is a British Side by Side Championship the high gun will be awarded to the highest score using a British made gun. A separate prize will be awarded to the highest gun using an imported Side by Side.

The course will comprise of 100 targets all simulating typical English quarry, spread over 12 stands, including our 120 foot High Tower, through out Sporting Targets 40 acre estate.

The out come will be decided by the highest scores in each of the categories at 2.30pm, approximately, followed by prize giving on Sunday 29th August.

The overall high gun will receive the prestigious British Side by Side Championship Cup, to keep for one year and then defend or relinquish in 2011.

In addition a trophy will be awarded in each of the gauges, as well as Seniors, Ladies, Veterans and colts.

In the event of a tie, for the High Gun, a shoot off will take place, for all other places and trophies count back will be applied. See rules.

***Safety, hearing and eye protection is compulsory and the wearing of protective head gear is recommended.
Please do not bring dogs.***

Rules of Entry To The British Side by Side Championships 2010

All entries should be booked and paid for in advance by phone 01234 708893.

Re-entry is permitted, if you wish to do this then you will shoot in the morning and then again in the afternoon on Saturday. On Sunday you will shoot before 10.30 am and then again in the early afternoon. You need to make us aware when you book that you wish to re-enter as this cannot be guaranteed on the day.

Entry cost is £40.00 (re-entry will be an additional £30.00) this includes a buffet lunch, clays, but not cartridges.

Lunch will be served between 12.00pm and 1.00pm so if you are only shooting in the afternoon on Saturday you will need to arrive before 1.00pm for lunch.

All entries will shoot in squads of no more than six with an appointed start time.

All squads will have a referee, whose decision is final.

All shooters will wear Ear and Eye protection, failure to do so will prohibit participation and/or disqualification from the competition.

All shooters will abide by Sporting Targets club rules, all guns must be carried broken and unloaded at all times, unless on a designated shooting stand.

Cartridge size must not exceed 28 gram load, shot size 6

All entries will be classified as either Senior, Lady, Junior or Veteran.

All entries must disclose the make and gauge of their gun, and only this gun may be used by that entrant for the competition. Switching guns during the course of the competition will be exempt from winning any prizes.

All prizes and trophies will be presented on 28th August once the final results are in, approximately 2.30pm. In the event of a draw for the high gun a shoot off will take place on an instant death basis at a stand determined by Sporting Targets on the day. All other prizes and trophies will be decided on a count back basis, meaning the first person to miss a target from Stand One through to Stand Twelve will be deemed to have lost. Trophies will only be awarded to those shooting with a British gun. All imported guns will compete for a separate trophy all in one class irrespective of gauge, Senior, Veteran, lady or Junior.

The High Gun is determined by the highest score achieved using a British made gun.
